**FOSS4G** is the global conference focused on Free and Open Source Software for Geospatial, organized by OSGeo. In 2014, FOSS4G will be held in Portland, Oregon, after being held in Nottingham, Denver, Barcelona, Sydney and Cape Town in past years. The most recent international FOSS4G event held in North America was in Denver, Colorado, in 2011.

FOSS4G gathers developers and users of open source geospatial software as well as managers and decision-makers from around the world to discuss new directions, exciting implementations, and growing business opportunities in this space. Recent years have seen substantial changes in the geospatial industry. One of those changes has been the growth in maturity and adoption of free and open source solutions. In many cases organizations are using a mixture of open and closed source solutions.

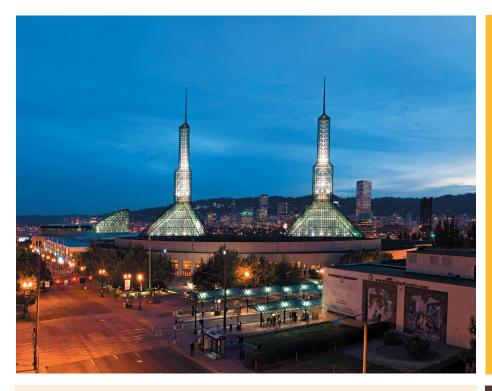
